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Use of the Pupil Deprivation Grant at Maesglas Primary School

The number on roll at Maesglas Primary School in September 2014 was 289 including 49 in the Nursery.

The percentage of pupils on roll eligible for free school meals is 43%, representing an increase on last year of 5%.

The total amount of grant funding available to school this year is £62424

The school undertakes the following activities in order to support pupils facing the challenges of poverty and deprivation: -

1. Releasing outstanding teachers of Mathematics and English to work alongside colleagues to offer support and advice
2. Purchase of reading materials to support pupil learning
3. Group and individual reading support
4. Group and individual numeracy support
5. Purchase and use of IT equipment and programmes to support pupil learning, including for use with family engagement
6. Family engagement activities, including offering advice on child behaviour and attendance issues, plus supporting pupil learning

The school's PDG, SEG and WEG Plans are regularly scrutinised by the Governing Body, supported by advice from the EAS and monitored by the Local Authority
